The Gospel Broadcasting Network is a project overseen by the elders of the Highland Church of Christ in Dalton Georgia. They are in the process of raising \$1 million dollars to enter into a contract with a company that will place the network on a satellite for nationwide distribution.

The satellite's coverage will include part of Canada, the Caribbean, and most of Central America. GBN has confirmed to us that "God's Answers to Life's Questions" will be part of the 48 hours of original programming shown each week. We are now sending DVDs of the program to Jim Dearman, the program director.

GBN will offer a sharp contrast to the "night club" religion that is prevalent on the denominational religious networks currently available.

People will be drawn to the simple powerful message of the Gospel with an emphasis on just preaching and teaching the Bible. Only eternity will reveal the total impact this network will have on the souls of men.

Sam Clark, our agent went to work and renegotiated our contract. Because of his experience and skill, we actually came out better than when we began. We found out that more people have access to our program

than ever!

On Sunday nights at 10:30, 52.3% of the nations is watching television. This is a good figure, but Monday nights at 10:30 is just as good with 52% watching television. When one adds Sunday morning at 6:30 to the equation, an additional 30% of the nation is watching. So our market has increased by 30%.

The Word is Getting Out

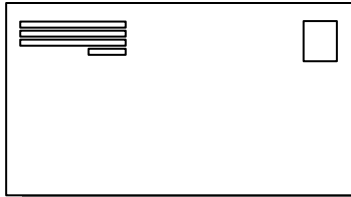
We frequently get calls at the office asking us about the program. Because of the time change on April 2, a number of people called to find out the new times.
