We can hardly believe a whole year has passed since we produced our first program. It took more than a dozen hours to produce program 501, "Where Can I Find the Truth?" in December 2004.

On December 11, 2005, we were able to tape three programs in just a few hours. Thanks to the hard work of men like Jimmie Tullis, Chad Westmoreland, Mike Walker, Glenn Gentry, and Tommy Burnett, we are able to do our work with great efficiency.

We have changed the scenery and improved lighting and sound since the first program. We have learned so much about recording, editing and producing the DVDs necessary to air this program.

The program first aired on Sunday nights at 10:30, but we were bumped by WNPX to a different time slot. Through the keen efforts of Sam Clark, our agent of record, we changed time slots from Sunday nights to Sunday mornings at 6:30 a.m. and added Monday nights at 10:30 p.m. We are blessed to have such a talented man to help us in our work.

In July we were able to use our website, www.tv.God-answers.org, to allow viewers to download our transcripts and to see the program 24/7.

In August, Jonathan Jenkins invited us to post our program on his website: Digitalbiblestudy.com. You can still find many of our programs in their archives.

In October, Willie Hamblen invited us to send him DVDs to air our program on Good-News-network.org. We are so grateful for every opportunity that has

come our way.

Since July, we have received over 13,000 hits to our website with 1,567 visits viewing 2,744 pages. Several church websites now link to our television website. Many of our viewers also get the advantage the large offerings on our congregational website, where they can download the 'Upon the Rock Bible Study Series.'

Our website allows people from all over the world to access information. In recent months people from Portugal, Brazil, Zimbabwe, United Kingdom, Ukraine, Belgium, South Korea, Austria, Canada, the Netherlands, Germany, and Norway have visited our tv.God-answers.org website. In addition to these nations we have had visitors from the U.S. Government connections and the U.S. Education sites. We are making a difference.

In recent days people have visited Concord Rd. because they heard about us through the "God Answers" program.

We hope in the coming years to become a program representing churches of Christ not only in middle Tennessee and Kentucky but throughout the region and the country, if the Lord wills.

Each week we will advertise a website where people can find a local congregation near their homes. Our desire is that the church everywhere may grow and prosper. Please keep us in your prayers as we enter into our second year as a gospel outreach to a lost and dying world.
