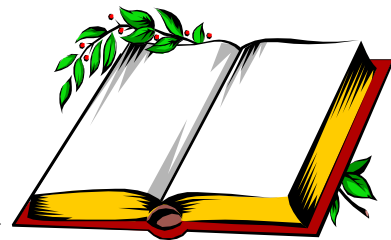

## A Brand New Year to Serve the Lord

The beginning of a new year causes all of us to reassess where we have been, where we are now, and where we are going.

The future looks bright for "God's Answers"! We are receiving calls and letters each week, and our internet site shows that people are downloading our transcripts and watching our videos. We set a new record in January for the amount of material downloaded from our website. Just this month we had 2700 hits and 300 visits viewing about 1600 files.

The point of "God's Answers" is to reach out to the hundreds of thousands of viewers who are active in their faith and attending a local congregation. As many as 20 million American adults now say they have "no religion." Hundreds of thousands of these "no religion" people live in the Nashville viewing area. They need the gospel.

A second group we are trying to reach are those who used to attend the church but have quit going altogether. People in both groups are facing life alone without the help of the Lord, because they have distanced themselves from Him. We are trying to bring them back to the Lord, to His Word, and to His church. Thousands of people who have fallen away live within our viewing area.

Jesus said, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned" (Mark



16:15-16).

## Is Anybody Listening?
