Great News for Gospel Broadcasting Network!

The Gospel Broadcasting Network has now raised \$1, 212, 000 in donations and have designed Sept. 24 as their "Sattelite Saturday," when they will begin airing for the first time.

GBN will broadcast throughout North America from Canada to Mexico to more than a million viewers with the large dish.

GBN is currently in nego-

tiations with Direct TV to begin airing with them as well. If things work out with Direct TV, they will air to 14 million homes, representing more than 30 million people.

Director Barry Gilreath Sr. has assured us that "God's Answers" will be part of that original 48 hours of programming. The "God's Answers" program will air up to

four times per week.

More than 270 churches are now supporting the Gospel Broadcasting Network, which will air only programs that reach out with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Is Anybody Watching?

Most people who think about television evangelism ask if anybody is watching. Everyone wants to use the Lord's money in the most expedient way. Is television a good investment. According to the Nielson company 30 percent of viewers with televisions are watching tv on Sunday mornings at 6:30 am and 52 percent are watching on Mondays at 10:30 pm.

If only one in a thousand viewers in the Nashville market were watching our program, the audience would still be more than a thousand actual viewers on Sunday mornings and nearly two thousand on Monday nights. We believe with your help we can increase this number significantly.

Not long ago, the young man who mows my yard asked me, "Are you on television? We thought we saw you the other night." I told him that I was, and we began to talk about the Lord and his church.

Several years ago I learned from Mack Lyon that television evangelism was a cumulative matter. He said that it takes about a year in a market before people really begin noticing what you are saying and doing for the Lord.

When evangelists preach the truth in love, they will in time build a rapport with the audience. This won't happen quickly, but each year that rapport grows as viewers learn to trust the speaker.

Television evangelism seeks to sow the seed broadly to every soul that will take the time to watch. Some will catch simply by browsing.

It cannot guarantee results; no ministry can do that. But it can reach into the lives of people, who may not be willing to come to church. It can touch people who are confined to a bed or a nursing home.

Is anyone watching? Yes, and it may surprise you to find out who!
