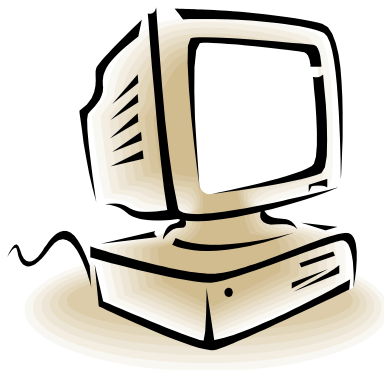


We Are Making Progress!

We set several new records on our website during the month of March, which tells us that people are watching and finding out more.

We had a record **352 visits** to



tv.God-answers.org from 332 sites viewing over 550 pages, downloading over 38 megabytes of material in **1600 files**.

Since January, numerous countries have looked at our television website. These include Saudi Arabia, Japan, Canada, Portugal, India, Italy, Mexico, Poland, Belarus, Germany, Ukraine, Sweden, Costa Rica, Tanzania, and Croatia. Others from the U.S. Military have linked to our site. These links could be from any military base in the world.

During the month of March alone we also had over **900 hits** on the "Upon the Rock" Bible studies at www.God-answers.org.

Our congregational website, www.God-answers.org has now sur-

passed the million mark in the number of hits in the last year. It has averaged a record **3,837 hits** and 462 visits **per day** during the month of March. We are making a profound impact with the gospel.

You probably have noticed that we have begun the program recently with a ten-second teaser in order to gain more interest.

We are using some slides containing Scripture to help our viewers to see what the Bible says as well as hear the message.

We are planning to tape some additional songs for broadcast in the near future. We also will be updating the one-minute segment on the congregation to encourage attendance in churches of Christ.

Our desire from the beginning has been to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ to people who have not been to church in years and to bring back those who have left the church.

We believe that preaching the truth is the best means of reaching people with the gospel. Television is still the most cost effective means of reaching out to people. When we put together the work we are doing on WNPX with what we are doing online, we are making progress! We pray God will continue to give us the increase in the coming months and years.
