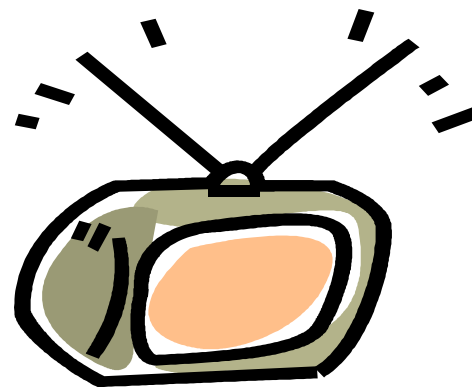
We were able to sit down together a few weeks ago in Florence, Alabama, at the Heritage Christian University lectures. Willie told me the wonderful goals of taking the

George Barna revealed this month that many young adults are looking for alternatives to a traditional church service.

The new research shows that more than fifty million adults now practice their faith through a variety of divergent faith models
